11. What must you believe about God?

81. Do you pray to anyone else besides God?

I pray to the Blessed Virgin Mary because she is the Mother of God and my Mother. I pray to the Saints and to my Guardian Angel.

82. What are the Ten Commandments?

The Ten Commandments are:

- 1. I, the Lord, am your God, you shall not have other gods besides Me.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord, your God, in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the sabbath day.
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.
- 5. You shall not kill.
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.
- 7. You shall not steal.
- 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- 10. You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor.
